

## Academy of the Performing Arts 2011-2012 Payment Options

Tuition may be paid by the following methods:

- ☞ **Post-Dated Checks:** This option requires nine post-dated checks written for the 7<sup>th</sup> of each month of the 2011-2012 season. These checks are only deposited on the 7<sup>th</sup>. In the event of a withdrawal from classes, all unused checks after the 30-day withdrawal period will be returned. See the Withdraws section of the Dance Policy for the proper withdrawal procedure. A \$30 fee is added to accounts whose payment is returned due to insufficient funds or stop payment.
  
- ☞ **Automatic Credit Card Payments:** Tuition is automatically charged to your credit or debit card on the 7<sup>th</sup> of each month. In the event of a withdrawal from classes, all charges after the 30-day withdrawal period will end. See the Withdraws section of the Dance Policy for the proper withdrawal procedure. Accounts having cards declined or that allow only partial payment will accrue a \$5 late charge per APA business day until full payment is received.
  
- ☞ **Single All-Inclusive Payment:** This is a full year's tuition paid in one lump sum via cash, check, or credit card before the start of the dance year. Single Payments receive the Post-Dated Check Rate as well as a 5% discount on the total tuition. No refunds are given for withdrawals. Payments made by credit card will be charged a \$5 processing fee.
  
- ☞ **Personal Monthly Payment:** Tuition is paid in person or via postal mail by the 7<sup>th</sup> of each month by cash, check, or credit card. Unpaid accounts accrue a \$5 late charge on the 8<sup>th</sup> of each month and a \$10 late charge on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. A \$30 fee is added to accounts whose payment is returned due to insufficient funds or stop payment. ***Accounts choosing this option must pay for the first and last month's tuition at the time of registration.*** In the event of a withdrawal from classes, the last month's tuition will be used toward the final amount due. See the Dance Policy for the proper withdrawal procedure. A \$30 fee is added to accounts whose payment is returned due to insufficient funds or stop payment.
